The Unstuffy Symphony



Current Symphony Policy based on CDC Guidance Revised August 14, 2022

- 1. No longer recommending testing for asymptomatic people.
- 2. If exposed to COVID-19, wear a high-quality mask for 10 days, and get tested on day 5. Quarantining is no longer recommended.
- 3. If you have COVID-19, or any of its symptoms, or are sick, isolate yourself, and get tested. If your results are positive, stay home and isolate yourself for 5 days. After 5 days, and you are fever-free without medications, and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5. *Free* at-home kits will be provided by the Symphony.
- 4. If you have had a <u>moderate illness</u> shortness of breath or difficulty breathing), or a <u>severe illness</u> (you were hospitalized due to COVID-19), or you have a weakened immune system, you need to isolate for 10 days.
- 5. If you test negative for COVID-19, you can end isolation.
- 6. If you think you might be sick or have had any exposure to COVID-19, do NOT come to rehearsal.
- 7. Masks are no longer required but are optional. If you wish a high-quality mask, the Symphony will provide one for you at no cost.
- 8. The Symphony will continue to provide its air filtration systems and enhanced ventilation at all rehearsals.
- 9. The Symphony, along with CDC guidance, continues to recommend being vaccinated and be up to date with your boosters, but is no longer required.
